- For questions and answers, the questioner should express his / her intention in chat during the presentation. The chair will choose questioner.
- Connection test: The presenter must perform a connection test. We will contact presenters directly about the date and time.
- \*If you are not a presenter and would like to have a connection test, please contact person in charge (nakaba@cc.tuat.ac.jp).
- The abstract of the presentation will be **about half a page of A4 paper**. For the submission, we will contact the presenters directly.
- The contents that have already been presented are also acceptable. Therefore, we do not inhibit duplication of the presentations at this meeting with the 70th Annual Meeting of the Japan Wood Research Society in Tottori.
- We leave the decision on whether to deal the presentation at this meeting as a research achievement up to individual presenters. When you use the presentation at this meeting as a research achievement, please pay attention to the content and title to avoid duplication. If you are a student, please discuss with your supervisor before application.
- If there are too many applications, we will select the presentation based on the research field and affiliation.
